



## Directions to Rabun Gap-Nacoochee School

339 Nacoochee Drive, Rabun Gap, GA 30568

### From Atlanta, GA

Take I-85 N then 985 to Gainesville. 985 becomes 365 north of Gainesville. 365 will merge with 441. Stay on 441 to Clayton. RGNS is 7 miles north of Clayton on 441. You will see the campus on the hill to your left as you travel north. Proceed to Jane Woodruff Dormitory.

### From Athens, GA

Take 441 north to Clayton. RGNS is 7 miles north of Clayton on 441. You will see the campus on the hill to your left as you travel north. Proceed to Jane Woodruff Dormitory.

### From Asheville, NC

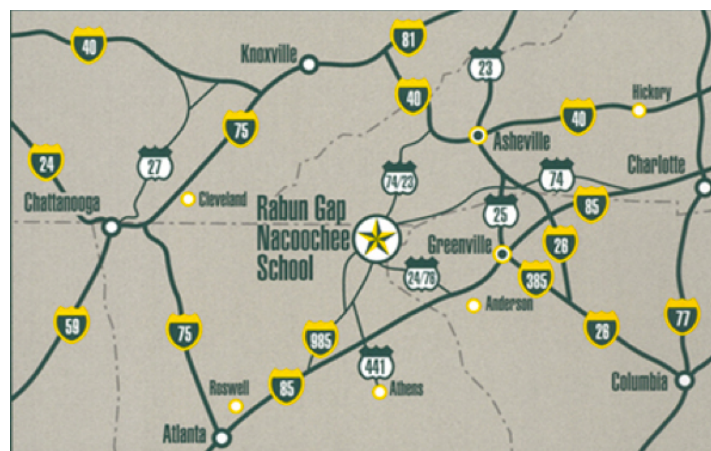
Take I-40 west to Waynesville and get off at exit 27. Take 19/23 to Sylva. Just past Sylva exit onto 441 south toward Atlanta. Stay on 441. RGNS is located south of Franklin about 17 miles. You will see the campus on the hill to your right as you travel south. Proceed to Jane Woodruff Dormitory.

### From Charlotte, NC

Take I-85 south through Greenville to SC11 (Exit 1), SC24 to Westminster, US76 west to Clayton, US441/23 north 7 miles to Rabun Gap. You will see the campus on the hill to your left as you travel north. Proceed to Jane Woodruff Dormitory.

### From Greenville, SC

Take I-85 south to SC11 (Exit 1), SC24 to Westminster, US76 west to Clayton, US441/23 north 7 miles to Rabun Gap. You will see the campus on the hill to your left as you travel north. Proceed to Jane Woodruff Dormitory.

### Directions to Jane Woodruff Dormitory

Registration for YAHS students arriving on July 5 takes place at Jane Dormitory, #12 on the map above. Registration for Prep Division students arriving on July 6 takes place at Ernest Dormitory, #11 on the map above.

To get to the dorms, turn into the main campus entrance from Rt. 441, with the track on your right and building #19 on your left; follow the road around to the stop sign at building #4. Turn left. Turn left again at building #6 and make an immediate right, following the road in front of buildings #8–11 to the parking lot in back of Jane dorm. (Note: you cannot access Jane from the road running directly behind it, pictured above.)

YAHS signs will be posted on campus showing you the way to Jane Dorm.

Other buildings we will be using this year:

- #1 Rearden Theater: location of performance classes and concerts.
- #6 Dining Hall, where meals are served.

While on campus students have access to the track, tennis courts, basketball hoops, sand volleyball, gazebo, swings, fields, and walkways. (Bring your own sports equipment.) Young Artist Division students are not permitted to leave the campus perimeter pictured above without special permission. Our swimming lake is outside this perimeter and considered off campus.
